## West Basin/NRG Recycled Water Pipeline Project CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY ON FRANKLIN AVENUE AT MAIN STREET

- WHO: West Basin Municipal Water District (West Basin)
- WHAT: Installation of a 10-inch diameter recycled water pipeline
- WHEN: Tuesday, July 31, 2012 through Friday, September 20, 2012 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.  
Hours and dates subject to change.
- WHERE: Franklin Avenue between Main Street and Standard Street and Franklin Avenue between Main Street and Richmond Street

### WHAT TO EXPECT:

- No through traffic on Franklin Avenue between Main Street and Standard Street.
- No through traffic on Franklin Avenue between Main Street and Richmond Street.
- Construction signs notifying drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians of construction.
- Construction work hours will occur Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Construction activities will include saw-cutting, digging the trench, excavation, tunnel work, installation of the pipe, trench backfilling and base street resurfacing. Asphalt resurfacing will occur after September. Businesses and residents will be notified in advance.
- Heavy construction machinery will be used including a bore machine and a 30-foot drill rig.
- Other construction impacts will include noise, dust and vibration.

### BACKGROUND:

This recycled water pipeline project is part of the West Basin's Water Reliability 2020 program to decrease the region's dependence on imported water from 66% to 33% by 2020. West Basin is expanding its recycled water program, doubling conservation, expanding education programs, and developing ocean-water desalination to protect our drinking water supply and increase water reliability.

This project consists of the installation of approximately 7,400 feet of 10-inch diameter pipeline that will convey 470,000 gallons per day of single pass reverse osmosis (high purity) recycled water for industrial use in the City of El Segundo. Using recycled water for industrial and commercial use saves potable (drinking) water for residential use.
