The El Segundo Police Department is currently accepting cellular phone donations for reuse or recycling. Donated phones are then sent for processing. Those that are reusable are placed into a nationwide 9-1-1 Cell Phone Bank, available to all law enforcement agencies.



The El Segundo Police Department has phones ready for distribution to citizens of any age. (A parent must request a phone for children under 18.) The phones are programmed to call 9-1-1 only.

Cellular phones deemed unusable will be responsibly recycled.
