### Theft Suspect Arrested

On December 5, 2013, El Segundo Police began investigating a theft of LA LAKERS memorabilia taken from the LAKERS training facility, 500 block north Nash Street. Items taken in the theft included gift cards valued at nearly \$20K as well as two LAKERS championship rings from the 2009, and 2010 seasons.

Following extensive investigation, Detectives identified the suspect as a facility security guard.

On December 10, 2013, Detectives arrested the suspect outside the training facility as he left work. A search of the suspect's home in Inglewood yielded evidence of the theft as well as the championship rings.

Monterosso was booked at the El Segundo Police jail for burglary and grand theft. On December 12, 2013, the District Attorney filed felony charges of burglary and grand theft.
