Offices to be Elected:	Member of the City Council (four year term) – Vote for No More than Three City Clerk (four year term) – Vote for One City Treasurer (four year term) – Vote for One

Dates to Remember:	
March 14, 2016	First day for mailing Permanent Vote-by-Mail Voter Ballots.
March 14, 2016 to April 5, 2016	Voter may request Vote-by-Mail Ballots with for the April 12, 2016 General Municipal Election.
March 22, 2016	Last day to Mail Sample Ballot/Voter Information Pamphlet and Polling Place Locations. (Must be mailed to registered voters no later than this date.)
March 28, 2016	Last day to register to vote for this the April 12, 2016 General Municipal Election
April 12, 2016	ELECTION DAY!
Polling Places:	To find your polling place, please refer to your Sample Ballot/Voter Information Pamphlet. On election day, the polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.
Election Results:	Ballots received from the polling places and most vote-by-mail ballots will be counted in the Council Chamber at City Hall on election night. These preliminary results will be posted on the City's website. The final results will be declared by the City Clerk at the Regularly scheduled City Council meeting, Tuesday, May 3, 2016. At the same meeting the newly elected official will be sworn into office and the City Council will select one of its members as the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem.
