Expansion of an Outdoor Recreation Vehicle Storage Facility

Address: 1 Chapman Way/655 S. Douglas Street and an Adjacent

and Contiguous Portion of the Union Pacific Railroad

Right-of-Way

Applicant: California Storage Masters

Property Owner: Kramer H. & Co.; Union Pacific Railroad

The applicant proposes to expand an existing outdoor recreation vehicle storage facility located in the Light Industrial (M-1) Zone. The area of expansion is located to the northeast of the existing parking area. The existing parking facility is approximately 178,000 square feet accommodating 234 vehicles and the area of expansion is 33,900 square feet (0.78 acres) and will accommodate 52 new vehicles. The project site is located west of Douglas Street and northeast of Chapman Way (a private road). The Planning and Building Safety Department Director has approved the application in accordance with El Segundo Municipal Code (ESMC) Sections 15-6A-7(A.2.b), 15-22-2 and 15-22-5.

3. Environmental Assessment No. 668 and Subdivision No. 05-05

Address: 301 N. Sepulveda Boulevard
Applicant: Patrick Ayau, Lee & Associates
Property Owner: Amherst Capital Partners

The application involves the subdivision of eight parcels into two parcels. The proposed project includes the development of a commercial project comprised of a 13,560 square-foot retail drug store on one parcel and a 7,800 square-foot multi-tenant retail building and a 2,575 square-foot restaurant on the second parcel. All structures are proposed to be one-story in height and will not exceed 33 feet at the highest point with 113 at-grade surface parking spaces provided throughout the parcels. The subject property is located in the General Commercial (C-3) Zone. The site is surrounded by a hotel and commercial uses in the General Commercial (C3) Zone to the north and south respectively; light industrial and manufacturing uses in the Medium Manufacturing (MM) Zone to the west; and offices and commercial uses in the Corporate Office (CO) Zone to the east.
