The request must include a brief general description of the business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting. Playing of video tapes or use of visual aids may be permitted during meetings if they are submitted to the Planning and Building Safety Director a minimum of two working days before the meeting and they do not exceed five minutes in length.

The proposed project is a request to subdivide a parcel for the purpose of constructing two condominium units for commercial and/or industrial uses on a property located at 149 Standard Street. Permits have been previously issued for constructing a two story, 37-foot high, 4,162 square-foot building and 14 off-street parking spaces. The project site is located in the Small Business (SB) Zone within the Smoky Hollow Specific Plan area. The

existing parcel is 50.06' wide and 140.01' deep, totaling 7,008.9 square feet in area and meets the minimum lot size of 5,600 square feet. The maximum allowable building floor area is 4,205 square feet. The project site is located within the block bordered by Franklin Avenue to the north, El Segundo Boulevard to the south, an alley to the west, and Standard Street to the east.
