The Planning Commission, with certain statutory exceptions, can only take action upon properly posted and listed agenda items.

Unless otherwise noted in the Agenda, the public can only comment on City-related business that is within the subject-matter jurisdiction of the Planning Commission and items listed on the Agenda during the **Public Communications** portion of the meeting. Additionally, the public can comment on any public hearing item on the Agenda during the public hearing portion of such item. The time limit for comments is generally limited to five minutes per person.

Members of the public may request that items be placed on the Agenda by submitting a **Written Request** to the Planning and Building Safety Director at least ten days before the Planning Commission Meeting (by 10:00 a.m. the Monday of the prior week). The request must include a brief general description of the business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting. Playing of video tapes or use of visual aids may be permitted during meetings if they are submitted to the Planning and Building Safety Director a minimum of two working days before the meeting and they do not exceed five minutes in length. Written materials distributed to the Planning Commission within 72 hours of the Planning Commission meeting are available for public inspection immediately upon distribution in the City Clerk's office.

Project Summary

The proposed project involves the development of an office-industrial business park project comprised of five, one and two-story buildings totaling 88,249 square feet on 4.46 acres of land. The proposed uses on the site would be primarily light industrial uses (at least 50 percent), offices, and restaurants. The buildings would be subdivided into 55 commercial condominium air space units. The proposed project would have a floor-area-ratio of 0.38, a maximum building height of 35 feet and 264 parking spaces. The subject property is located in the Medium Manufacturing (MM) Zone. The site is located on the block bounded by Grand Avenue to the north, Franklin Street to the south, Kansas Street to the west, and the Military Entrance Processing Station at 1700 E. Grand Avenue to the east.

Mitigated Negative Declaration

An initial study of environmental impacts was prepared pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations § 15063 ("CEQA Guidelines"). A Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impacts is proposed for this project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15070. The public review and comment period for the Negative Declaration begins on December 26. 2008 and ends on January 26, 2009.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Planning Commission (1) open the public hearing and take documentary and testimonial evidence; (2) after considering the evidence adopt Resolution No. 2651; and (3) discuss and take any other action related to this item.
