
INTRODUCTION



Overall, crime in 2009 increased 11% compared to the previous year.









2009 BURGLARY




2009 LARCENY




2009 VEHICLE THEFT



2009 REPORTED CRIMES






FIELD OPERATIONS BUREAU ACTIVITY


Based on Part I Crime Incidents by Month of Year




Based on Part I Crime Incidents by Day of Week



Based on Part I Crime Incidents by Time of Day







The Investigative Division has the primary responsibility of investigating crimes that occur within the City.




SPECIAL OPERATIONS DIVISION ACTIVITY



TRAFFIC COLLISION AND PRIMARY COLLISION FACTORS COMPARISON 2008-2009






ANIMAL CONTROL ACTIVITY


