
INTRODUCTION



The statistical crime data in this report provides the Police Department a view of criminal trends and conduct as a tool for crime analysis.

Overall, crime in 2010 decreased 24% compared to the previous year.









2010 BURGLARY




2010 LARCENY





FIELD OPERATIONS ACTIVITY


The Investigative Division has the primary responsibility of investigating crimes that occur within the City.




SPECIAL OPERATIONS ACTIVITY





TRAFFIC COLLISION AND PRIMARY COLLISION FACTORS COMPARISON 2009-2010








ANIMAL CONTROL ACTIVITY


