The request must include a brief general description of the business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting. Playing of video tapes or use of visual aids may be permitted during meetings if they are submitted to the Planning and Building Safety Director a minimum of two working days before the meeting and they do not exceed five minutes in length.

 - 2. Environmental Assessment No. EA-979 and Administrative Determination No. 12-01

Address: 1212-1320 East Imperial Avenue

Applicant(s): City of El Segundo

Property Owner: Various

The Director of Planning and Building Safety is referring an Administrative Determination to the Planning Commission to determine the permitted legal nonconforming commercial uses for six properties located at 1212-1320 East Imperial Avenue in the R-3 (Multi-Family Residential) Zone pursuant to El Segundo Municipal Code (ESMC) Chapter 15-21 regarding Nonconforming Buildings and Uses. The General Plan classification and the zoning designation for the properties involved were changed in 1993 to allow multi-family residential uses rather than commercial uses. Consequently, the non-residential uses on the property became legal non-conforming. The General Plan classification was changed from Neighborhood Commercial to Multi-Family Residential and the zoning designation was changed from Neighborhood Commercial (C-2) to the Multi-Family Residential (R-3) Zone. The subject properties are located beginning at the southwest corner of Imperial Avenue and California Street and continuing approximately ½ block to the west. The property is surrounded by single-family uses to the south, multi-family residential uses to

the west, a hotel use to the east, and open space, Imperial Avenue and the Los Angeles International Airport to the north.

The project is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations §15301 as a Class 1 categorical exemption (Existing Facilities), § 15305 as a Class 5 categorical exemption (Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations), and §15321 as a Class 21 categorical exemption (Enforcement Actions by Regulatory Agencies).

ACTION: Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 2720. Approved (3-0).
