Composite Sketches of Burglary Suspects Posing as Plumbers



On Thursday, October 21, 2010 at approximately 3:00 pm, a resident in the 400 block of Hillcrest was contacted at his front door by a subject described as a male Hispanic 40-50 years of age, 5'9", 175 lbs. with weathered and wrinkled skin. The subject, who was wearing a yellow construction hard hat, boots and carrying a clipboard, advised the resident of a broken sewer line in the area. Further, he needed to check the victim's residence for any sewage and water leaks. The victim was led to the backyard and asked to run the water, while the suspect inspected the house. While in the house alone, the suspect quickly ransacked the bedrooms and fled with several items of significant value.

On Friday, October 22, 2010 at approximately 1:30 pm, a resident in the 600 block of Bungalow was victim to the same type of distraction theft by a suspect

matching the description of the prior day's incident. A second suspect was seen and described as male Hispanic 30-35 years, 5'10", 230-250lbs. Both suspects were possibly seen fleeing the area in a brown compact pick-up truck. The victims of both thefts were over 75 years of age and may have been targeted due to their age.

The suspects are believed to be involved in similar burglaries in Torrance, Hermosa Beach, the city of Los Angeles and other unincorporated cities in Los Angeles County. If you have any information about these thefts, please contact Detective Hugo Perez at 310-524-2216 (DR#10-3974 and 3978).
