

Family Fun Trips

All Family Fun Trips depart from and return to the Joslyn Center Parking Lot and are open to all ages unless otherwise stated. Registration for the Family Fun Trips is open during the Resident and Non-Resident Registration Dates listed on the back of the brochure. Refund Requests for the Family Fun Trips are processed at the Joslyn Center and must be made 2-weeks prior to the trip date. Effective October 1, 2014, the non-resident registration fee is 20% of the class fee (\$15 minimum).

Angelino Heights Docent Tour & Farmer's Market

This fun-filled day will include another great docent led tour by the LA Conservancy. The main part of the tour explores Historic Carroll Avenue, a street lined with Victorian homes from the late nineteenth century. The tour includes an inside peek of a couple of homes which have been fully restored. Carroll Avenue is on the National Register Historic District, and was designated in 1983 as the first historic district in the City of Los Angeles. It is considered one of the first suburbs of Los Angeles and is one of the few neighborhoods in Los Angeles remaining intact from the Victorian era. After the tour we will stop at the historic Farmer's Market for some lunch and shopping on your own. Trip fee includes the docent led tour and luxury bus transportation.

Pasadena Norton Simon & Fenyes Mansion Museum

This tour begins with a private group tour of the Simon Norton Museum before the museum is open to the public. Then we will have time for lunch and shopping on your own in downtown Pasadena before we have our second docent tour of the day at the Fenyes Mansion & Museum. Once home to Dr Adalbert and Eva Fenyes, this mansion is on Pasadena's famed 'Millionaire's Row' and is a special place among Pasadena Museum of History's many treasures. The mansion has original period furnishings, family heirlooms, and a unique California Plein Air art collection that enhance this 1906 Beaux Arts-style architectural jewel. The lovely residence, designed by Robert Farquhar with a later addition by Sylvanus Marston, retains the collection of the Fenyes-Curtin-Paloheimo family and is decorated as it was lived in a century ago. Fee includes two docent tours and bus transportation.

Community Garden

The El Segundo Community Garden is located on the North Side of Joslyn Center in Recreation Park. The gardens use square-foot gardening methods for growing plants and vegetables. The garden common areas are maintained by the community members and the individual gardens by the assigned resident. A variety of opportunities are available for community members including board management, volunteering, garden sales, and events. Garden plots are assigned to El Segundo residents via lottery at the beginning of the year. The next community garden lottery will take place for the East Garden in January 2015. If you are interested in being a part of our Community Garden you may be added to the lottery by calling, emailing or stopping by the Joslyn Center. Each garden is assigned for a period of 2 years.
