



Significant Updates

- Police and Fire Departments are fully staffed and operationally ready to respond to all local emergencies. Several non-emergency police positions (School Resource Officer, Community Lead Officer) have been reassigned to supplement patrol in a high visibility capacity in an effort to prevent crime and maintain order.
- City is currently at a level 2 response and has activated the All Hazard Incident Management Team (AHIMT). The team will work 12-hour operational periods in support of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Park Vista Division was created within the AHIMT and a safety plan has been established. An operations plan has been developed which includes food deliveries to the Park Vista residents and ensures their transportation needs are met. The division is finalizing a plan for pharmaceutical deliveries to the residents as well.
- A Shopper assistance program has been developed for elderly residents or those with underlying health conditions that need help with delivered goods. The AHIMT is working to include pharmaceutical needs as well. For information, call (310) 524-2705 or email: outreachhelp@elsegundo.org
- The following retailers will be providing early shopping hours for senior citizens:
 - Ralph's Market (500 N. PCH): 7 am to 7:30 am
 - Walgreens (331 N. PCH): 8 am to 9 am
 - Whole Foods (760 S. PCH): 7 am to 8 am
- Effective March 19, 2020 at 7 pm, the El Segundo Police Department lobby closed. Community members requiring non-emergency services may contact the police at 310-524-2200 or utilize the intercom system outside the front doors. Vehicle releases, citation payments, and report requests will be done by appointment only. Call 310-524-2200 in advance to set-up an available appointment. These protocols will remain in effect until further notice.
- Effective March 19, 2020, all City Parks, fields, sports courts, exercise equipment, and other recreation facilities including the Lakes Golf Course are closed. Individuals may still walk or jog through the parks, provided they maintain a social distance of six feet.
- On March 19, 2020, the Los Angeles County Health Officer issued the "Safer at Home Order for Control of COVID-19" which applies to most Los Angeles County cities including El Segundo. Governor Newsom also issued Executive Order N-33-20, which orders all individuals living in the State of California to stay at home or at their place of residence. The exceptions to this order are those who work in the 16 critical infrastructure sectors defined at <https://www.cisa.gov/identifying-critical-infrastructure-during-covid-19> as well as those needing such necessities as food, prescriptions, and

health care. When people need to leave their homes or places of residence, whether to obtain or perform the functions above, or to otherwise facilitate authorized necessary activities, they should at all times practice social distancing.

- Effective March 22, 2020, Spring Cleaners will be offering pick-up and delivery service for El Segundo residents. This service will be free to the elderly.

Current Initiatives

El Segundo is working with Park Vista on the best practices of COVID-19 mitigation with the property group.
El Segundo is working with philanthropic groups to provide for the needs of elderly and those with medical issues that have been advised to remain indoors.
Recreation and Parks is delivering meals on wheels.
El Segundo activated a COVID-19 Task Force to monitor the situation and coordinate plans and actions in preparation for pandemic conditions.
El Segundo established a crisis communications team to monitor information and approve messaging to the public.
Close all City Parks, to include all fields, sports courts, exercise equipment, and recreation facilities including the Lakes Golf Course. Signage regarding the closures has been posted.

External Operations Impacting El Segundo

Dockweiler Park: LA County OEM/LA County Dept of Health is utilizing Dockweiler RV Park as an isolation zone for people who have COVID-19 and have no place to self-isolate. El Segundo residents should avoid this area entirely and not go north of 12505 Vista Del Mar (the Youth Center and Beach Café).
