



**The Lakes at El Segundo  
Reopening Guidelines  
GOLF COURSE**



The rules and guidelines below are hereby effective immediately and are subject to change without prior notice. Based on current information and clinical health expertise, individuals over the age of 65 and any individuals of any age with underlying health conditions are recommended to use extreme caution before deciding to participate in any outdoor activity and/or close proximity to others during the COVID-19 global pandemic.

**General Guidelines:**

- Golf course is open to players only. No visitors are allowed. No individuals exhibiting flu-like symptoms will be permitted to play.
- Walking only allowed on the course.
- No golf carts or pull carts will be available for rent. Players must bring their own clubs and may bring their own pull carts. Players shall handle their own clubs and equipment.
- All tee times will be made online at [golftהלakes.com](http://golftהלakes.com) or by phone only.
- Groups are limited to four (4) players per starting time.
- Tee times will be spaced 10 minutes apart.
- There will be no cash accepted, credit cards only.
- All players must have a confirmed tee time, there will be no walk-ons.
- Please do not arrive at the course more than 20 minutes before your scheduled tee time.
- Stanchions and other delineators will be used to enforce proper social distancing upon check-in.
- All employees, visitors and golfers must use cloth face coverings at all times when in contact or near other people.
- The Clubhouse and golf shop will remain closed.
- Food and beverage will be limited and served through a pass through window.
- The restrooms will remain open and will be sanitized throughout the day, at least hourly.
- Sand bottles, scorecards, and pencils will not be available at this time.
- Rakes will be removed from the course.
- On-course water coolers have been removed. Please bring your own water bottle.
- The flagsticks and cups will be modified to prevent the ball from being holed. Do not touch the flagsticks.
- Always maintain the social distance of 6 feet over the entire property.
- All tournaments have been cancelled until further notice.
- Please proceed directly to your car and leave the property immediately following your round of golf.
- We will have staff monitoring and enforcing the above guidelines. Failure to adhere to these guidelines will lead us to ask you to leave and jeopardizes our ability to provide a healthy game of golf.
- Although we will make every effort to eliminate touch points and keep your experience safe, all customers that recreate at The Lakes at El Segundo, do so at their own risk.

### DRIVING RANGE

#### Practice Range Guidelines

- The range will be open for individual practice only. No spectators are allowed.
- All customers will be expected to leave the property once they have completed their bucket of balls. If necessary, a 1-hour maximum time limit for use of the driving range has been implemented.
- We will reduce the number of mats to ensure social distancing.
- The practice putting green will remain closed to reduce social congregation.
- Range balls are picked by machine, sanitized, soaked and washed prior to the next usage.
- All range baskets will be sanitized prior to each use.
