Imposing a Curfew Citywide
Order Issued: May 31, 2020

By virtue of authority vested in me as the City Manager of the City of El Segundo pursuant to the provisions of the El Segundo Municipal Code, Section 2-2-5, to promulgate, issue, and enforce rules, regulations, orders, and directives, I hereby declare the following orders to be necessary for the protection of life and property. This Order will take effect immediately and remain in effect until the current local emergency is terminated by City Council resolution.

This Order is issued in accordance with, and incorporates by reference, the May 30, 2020 Proclamation of a State of Emergency issued by Governor Gavin Newsom, for Los Angeles County and the City of Los Angeles, and the May 31, 2020 Declaration of Local Emergency issued by the City Manager.

PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 8630 AND EL SEGUNDO MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2-2, THE CITY MANAGER, ACTING AS THE EMERGENCY SERVICES DIRECTOR, ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

1. Effective May 31, 2020, a curfew will be in effect between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the state of local emergency.
2. During the curfew hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., no person shall be upon the public street, avenue, alley, park, way or other public place or unimproved public property within the City of El Segundo. This curfew shall not apply to:
 - a. Peace officers, firefighters, the National Guard or other military emergency personnel or disaster service workers.
 - b. Authorized representatives of any news service, newspaper, or radio or television station or network.
 - c. People going directly to and from their place of employment.
 - d. People accessing urgent medical care.
 - e. Essential critical infrastructure workers as that term is defined in State of California and L.A. County public health orders.

3. The El Segundo Police Department, along with law enforcement authorities cooperating with the El Segundo Police Department, are hereby authorized and charged, to the extent provided by law, with the responsibility of enforcing this curfew and are further authorized to arrest such persons that do not obey this curfew after due notice, oral or written, has been given to said persons. A violation of any of the above prohibitions constitutes a misdemeanor under El Segundo Municipal Code Section 2-2-8 and is punishable by fines not to exceed \$1,000 or imprisonment not to exceed six months. Further, the violation of any provision of this Order is declared to be a nuisance and may be abated by the City in accordance with its authority to abate nuisances. The remedies listed in this Order are not exclusive of any other remedies available to the City under any applicable Federal, State or local law.

This Order shall remain in effect until it is terminated by either the Director of Emergency Services, the City Council of the City of El Segundo, or the state of emergency is terminated.
