DUI/DRIVER LICENSE CHECKPOINT

On Friday August 31, 2012, the El Segundo Police Department will be conducting a DUI/Driver License checkpoint at an undisclosed location in the city. The hours of operation will be approximately 8:00 pm to 4:00 am.

El Segundo Police Officers along with officers from the Manhattan Beach Police Department, Inglewood Police Department, Hawthorne Police Department, and Gardena Police Department will be checking the sobriety and license status of drivers. DUI checkpoints are a proven deterrent and enforcement tool in reducing the number of persons killed and injured in alcohol involved crashes and heightening awareness of the dangers of impaired driving. DUI Checkpoints serve to show how serious law enforcement is to improving traffic safety.
