The City of El Segundo is once again hosting activities at Recreation Park during the day and the fireworks show at night. The fireworks are scheduled to begin at 9:00 PM.

To accommodate the fireworks show the following street closures will be in effect on July 4, 2014.

Closed at 4:00 PM

- Mariposa Avenue (south side of street) at
Eucalyptus Drive
Arena Street
Sheldon Street
Penn Street
- Pine Avenue at
Alley between Standard Street and Eucalyptus Drive
Eucalyptus Drive north and southbound
Alley between Eucalyptus Drive and Arena Street
Arena Street
Alley between Arena Street and Sheldon Street
Sheldon Street
Penn Street
Sierra Place
- Holly Avenue at
Standard Street east and westbound
Alley north and southbound between Eucalyptus Drive and Standard Street
- Sheldon Street at
East exit of Rec Park south parking lot

- Grand Avenue at Eucalyptus Drive northbound and west exit of Rec Park south parking lot

Closed at 7:00 PM

- Grand Avenue at
Standard Street – east and westbound
Eucalyptus Drive – north and southbound
Arena Street – southbound
Sheldon Street – east and westbound
Rite-Aid parking lot (Driveways on Grand Avenue and Standard Street)
Starbucks parking lot (Driveways on Grand Avenue)
- Franklin Avenue at
Eucalyptus Drive – preventing northbound traffic
Arena Street – preventing northbound traffic

Streets will remain closed until approximately 10:30 PM

The El Segundo Police Department wishes to remind its residents and visitors to be safe while enjoying the holiday festivities. Alcohol possession/consumption will not be permitted in public areas. There will be several block parties with restricted roadways throughout the residential area of the city and residents are encouraged to drive safely while traveling to their destinations.

Additional road closures may be required throughout the day dependent upon traffic congestion and safety issues.

As a reminder, it is illegal to possess or use fireworks in the City of El Segundo, including those considered “safe and sane.” Any possession or use of fireworks may result in the confiscation of those fireworks and criminal prosecution.
