1. CALL TO ORDER

 - E. Rachel suggested the City should join the C40 Climate Leadership Group, which is a network of cities around committed to addressing climate change. The EC to discuss the possibility of joining this network with City Council.

 - F. The EC asked about the possibility of publishing environmental-related articles in the City Newsletter. Jasmine informed the EC they can send her these environmental-related articles and she will include them in the next newsletter.
