ESTABLISHED

Economic Development Advisory Council: (Economic Development) is a spin-off of the City/Chamber of Commerce Business Retention and Attraction Task Force, originally established in 1990/91. The Committee was restructured in June 1994 as a 9-member committee by the City Council to implement the City's Economic Development Strategic Plan. Currently there are between 12 and 18 committee members due to the Council action on 03/31/15. On September 4, 2018 the City Council approved new by-laws to increase the number of members to 19 and to establish three year term of service for EDAC members.

NUMBER OF MEMBERS

EDAC is comprised of a 19 member council who represent a cross-section of the community, and include both residents and non-residents.

APPOINTMENT

All members are appointed by the City Council

TERM OF OFFICE

Three (3) year term, without term limits.

COMPENSATION

No compensation.

MEETINGS

The committee meets on the third Wednesday of every month at 4:30 p.m. at various locations.
