Saturday, December 21, 2019	<u><i>The HawtThorns</i></u> : Americana Husband-and-wife duo KP and Johnny Hawthorn employ sun-kissed songwriting, fiery electric guitar and lush vocal harmonies that evoke the California coastline as much as the Bible Belt countryside .
