



Significant Updates

- Police and Fire Departments are fully staffed and operationally ready to respond to all local emergencies. Several non-emergency police positions (School Resource Officer, Community Lead Officer) have been reassigned to supplement patrol in a high visibility capacity in an effort to prevent crime and maintain order.
- City is currently at a level 2 response and has activated the All Hazard Incident Management Team (AHIMT). The team will work 12-hour operational periods in support of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Each Department is nearing completion of a Continuity Of Operation Plan (COOP) to continue to support City services, while responding to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- City has developed a response plan for Park Vista which includes community mitigation actions aimed at reducing the opportunity of COVID-19 spread. Written notice is being provided to all residents of the facility requesting that they follow the actions listed.
- A Shopper assistance program has been developed for elderly residents or those with underlying health conditions that need help with delivered goods. The AHIMT is working to include pharmaceutical needs as well. For information, call (310) 524-2705 or email: outreachhelp@elsegundo.org

These protocols will remain in effect until further notice.

Current Initiatives

El Segundo is working with Park Vista on the best practices of COVID-19 mitigation with the property group.
El Segundo is working with philanthropic groups to provide for the needs of elderly and those with medical issues that have been advised to remain indoors.
Recreation and Parks is delivering meals on wheels.
El Segundo has activated a COVID-19 Task Force to monitor the situation and coordinate plans and actions in preparation for pandemic conditions.
El Segundo has established a crisis communications team to monitor information and approve messaging to the public.
El Segundo has closed the El Segundo Public Library, the Joslyn Center, and Recreation and Parks organized activities.

External Operations Impacting El Segundo

No Change at Dockweiler Park: LA County OEM/LA County Dept of Health is utilizing Dockweiler RV Park as an isolation zone for people who have COVID-19 and have no place to self-isolate. El Segundo is recommending residents avoid the area. County is taking delivery of 20-25 RVs per day. It is anticipated that the County will have the total number of RVs on site by the end of Thursday. El Segundo residents should not go north of 12505 Vista Del Mar where the Youth Center and Beach Café are.
