Significant Updates

- The Park Vista Division was created within the AHIMT and a safety plan has been established. An operations plan has been developed which includes food deliveries to the Park Vista residents and ensures their transportation needs are met. The division is finalizing a plan for pharmaceutical deliveries to the residents as well.
- Spring Cleaners is currently offering pick-up and delivery service for El Segundo residents. This service will be free to the elderly.
- The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health had reported on 3/22/20 that there were two confirmed COVID-19 cases in El Segundo. However, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has since determined this information to be inaccurate. They are currently reporting the number of confirmed cases in El Segundo to be one.
- The COVID-19 Senior Outreach Program now includes prescription medication delivery. If you are in need of assistance with food or medication delivery, please call 310-524-2705.
- The Los Angeles County Beaches and Harbors Division has closed all county beach parking lots, including the parking lot to El Segundo Beach located at Grand Avenue and Vista Del Mar. The beaches are remaining open for now.

El Segundo activated a COVID-19 Incident Management Team to monitor the situation and coordinate plans and actions in preparation for pandemic conditions.

External Operations Impacting El Segundo

Dockweiler Park: LA County OEM/LA County Dept of Health is utilizing Dockweiler RV Park as an isolation zone for people who have COVID-19 and have no place to self-isolate. El Segundo residents should avoid this area entirely and not go north of 12505 Vista Del Mar (the Youth Center and Beach Café).
