BURGLARY CAPTURED ON VIDEO



On April 16, 2017 at 1:16 A.M., El Segundo Police Officers responded to Chase Bank located 780 S. Sepulveda Blvd. (Plaza El Segundo) regarding a Burglary in progress alarm. The alarm company, who utilizes real time surveillance cameras, reported a tow truck had backed into the bank's glass front entrance and doorway. Also, person(s) could be seen inside the bank after the front glass had been shattered.

When Officers arrived, they found a trail of shattered glass and metal debris strewn across the parking. The ATM machines were still intact, but it is unknown at this time if the suspect(s) were targeting other items inside the bank.

Culver City PD located an abandoned flatbed AAA tow truck with T/C damage in their city at approximately 5:45 A.M. this morning. Based on the damage and description of this tow truck, it matches the description of the suspect vehicle depicted in the Chase Bank surveillance photos we obtained.
