ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON AGAINST A POLICE OFFICER

On March 25th @ 4:45 pm, an El Segundo Police Officer and his K9 partner were driving into work from the Inland Empire. The officer was traveling W/B on the I-10 freeway in Pomona when he was rear ended by a man driving a white Dodge Durango. As the officer changed lanes the vehicle followed behind and rear ended him again. The officer was rammed several more times as he attempted to evade the vehicle. The suspect vehicle eventually sped away in reverse on the freeway and exited on Indian Hill Blvd. in Pomona. With the assistance of Pomona PD and the California Highway Patrol, the suspect was eventually located. He admitted to officers he intentionally rammed the El Segundo Police car. The officer was injured as a result of the assault and treated at an area hospital where he was released a short time later. The police dog was not injured.

David Glen Dennison, a resident of Pomona, was arrested and charged with assault with a deadly weapon against a police officer, assaulting a police dog, criminal threats, and DUI. He was booked at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Walnut Station. The California Highway Patrol - Baldwin Park station is handling the arrest and investigation.
