Robbery Suspects Arrested

An attempt carjacking/robbery occurred on November 3rd at approximately 3:15 AM in a residential driveway in the 1400 block of East Maple Avenue. The two victims were both seated inside their vehicle, when the driver's door of their vehicle suddenly began to open. The victim grabbed the door to keep it from opening and observed two male black adults around the vehicle, both of which pointed an unknown object at them simulating a handgun. The victim started his vehicle and attempted to flee striking one of the suspects and a parked vehicle. Both suspects took off running towards a gray colored Chevrolet Suburban and the victims called 911.

An El Segundo Officer on patrol in the area observed the described suspect vehicle travelling e/b on Sycamore Avenue at Washington Street and conducted a felony traffic stop and detained two male suspects, **Larry Stansberry**, age 31, and **Edward Furdge**, age 26. Stansberry was paroled approximately 2 months ago for second degree robbery.

During the initial detention in the field, officers were notified that two separate robberies occurred earlier that morning, one in the City of Gardena and one in the City of Redondo Beach. Cash and a cell phone were taken in the Gardena robbery, and cash was taken in the Redondo Beach robbery. A handgun was simulated in both incidents.

The victims in our robbery as well as the victim from the Gardena robbery positively identified both suspects. Evidence from the Gardena robbery was located inside the suspect's vehicle. Furge and Stansberry were taken into custody and booked into the El Segundo Police Jail for 215(A) PC- Car Jacking and are each being held on \$100,000 bail.
